### RULES:

1. All exhibits must be "an original" work of the exhibitor and completed within the last year: class assignments done under supervision are not eligible for judging and should not be entered. Copies of all or significant parts of reproductions of artworks or photos not taken by the artist are not "original" and violate the copyright laws: do not enter them.
2. All Open Art must be framed and ready to hang with wires. NO ALLIGATOR CLIPS.
3. All entries must be plainly labeled on the back with the artist name, address, title of picture, date of painting and medium used.
4. Every possible care will be exercised in hanging exhibits, but no responsibility will be assumed. All insurance must be carried by the individual.
5. The management reserves the right to refuse any entry should it not be suitable for exhibit because of size or content.

### DEFINITIONS:

**BEGINNER:** An exhibitor who has NEVER WON A BLUE ribbon in the Open Fine Arts Department at the Colusa County Fair.

**INTERMEDIATE:** Exhibitors who HAVE WON A BLUE RIBBON and engages in an event or activity as a past time rather than a profession. Exhibitors who paint, draw and sculpt for a hobby. Money received does not exceed the cost of materials.

**ADVANCED/ PROFESSIONAL:** Exhibitors who put their artwork on display in an art show or gallery, with the intention of selling artwork. Instructors or teachers of art/sculpture are considered to be professional.

**PORTRAIT:** Can be people, animals, birds, etc., but must have features.

## SELL YOUR ARTWORK !

It is up to the artist to specify on the entry form the desired price. Artists are responsible for the commission of 15% and tax which will be given the Colusa County Art's Council and the Fair; so consider that in your pricing. Please title your work. Artwork is expected to remain on display throughout the Fair.
