RULES:

1. All exhibits must be original and the work of the exhibitor unless stated otherwise.
2. Exhibits must have been created by the exhibitor within one year of the opening date of the fair.
3. Handicraft Divisions are limited to exhibitors over 18 years of age as of January 1 of 2017.
4. The management reserves the right to refuse any entry should it not be suitable for exhibit because of size or content.
5. Any item weighing more than 150 pounds must be noted on the entry form. Please note size of item on entry form.

DEFINITIONS:

AMATEUR: Those who engage in an event or activity as a hobby, and whose returns from sales do not exceed the cost of the materials, and those who are not otherwise paid on account of engaging in this work, except for cash prizes or premium awards.

PROFESSIONAL: Anyone whose yearly income is 50% or more from the sales of Handicrafts listed below is considered a Professional and is not eligible for competition. Professionals are encouraged to contact the Fair Office regarding exhibition only of specimen exhibits.

All entries must be accompanied with copy of entry form, whether entered online or not

RULES

1. Entries shall be limited to residents of Colusa, Butte, Glenn, Lake, Sutter, Yolo and Yuba Counties.
2. Photos must have been taken within two (2) years prior to the date of the fair. Any print exhibited at this fair in previous years is not eligible.
3. Photos must have been taken by exhibitor and can be commercially processed.
4. Entries limited to two (2) per exhibitor per class, maximum total of 20 per exhibitor.
5. Entry form description column must clearly show title of each print entered.
6. The back of each print mount must include the print title, the division and class number and exhibitors name, address and phone number in the upper left corner. No name or title shall show on the front of the print or mount.
7. PHOTO SIZE. All photos will be a minimum 5"x7" or greater securely displayed in a sturdy single or double mat, or on a sturdy mount board with a maximum outside edge of 16"x 20" and READY TO BE HUNG. The matting must be secured tightly, as double sided tape does not always hold due to the
