Pre-Entry Prior to 5/31/24	Applications MUST be entered at the Colusa Fair Office by 5/31/24. The pre-entry fee is \$500.00. If you pre-enter on or before 5/31/24 and pass pit inspection you will receive a \$100.00 cash back! (for pre-entry only).
Entries after 5/31/24	** Limited spots available** Entries received after 5/31/24 are to be submitted at the Colusa Fair Office, or at the gate the day of the derby if spots are available. The entry fee is \$500.00. All Combines MUST pass pit inspection. These entry fees will be put back into the total purse payout.
Pit Pass-Open to ages 18 and up	\$25.00 (Liability waivers are required for all drivers and pit crew members)

- 100% of Truck Driver entry money will be added to Truck Payout Half to 1st, Half to 2nd PLACE
- 100% of all Combine Driver entry money will be added to MAIN EVENT PAYOUT HALF to 1st, HALF to 2nd PLACE
- Total Combine purse payouts may increase once all sponsorship opportunities are completed
- All derby combines, debris and pit equipment must be removed by midnight of derby night, or placed in the fairgrounds "storage lot" for future pick up. (Scrap metal bin may be provided by Fairgrounds) It shall be the sole responsibility of the combine driver to remove the combine and equipment from the arena and grounds or to make arrangements for it with the fair manager.
- \$1,000 fine will be issued if you do not move to storage area. Why? Clearence is needed for the Sunday Destruction Derby. Anything left after Saturday becomes property of the 44th DAA
