The Fair will make every effort to accommodate these exhibitors by providing appropriate departments, divisions and classes for organized groups such as FFA and 4-H as well as opportunities for Independent Exhibitors who are not members of an established club or organization.

Independent exhibitors may compete in the appropriate age class alongside FFA or 4-H exhibitors. If a significant number of independent exhibitors exist, separate divisions and classes may be created exclusively for independent exhibitors. We wish all exhibitors the best of luck and look forward to welcoming you to the Colusa County Fair.

ELIGIBILITY AND AGE REQUIREMENTS

4-H Age Requirements:

The levels of membership for 4-H are age based. Each level is defined as follows:

Primary Members:

Must be 5 years old by December 31 of each calendar year. Primary members cannot enroll in large animal projects.

Junior:

Exhibitor 9-10 years of age as of December 31 of each calendar year.

Intermediate:

Exhibitor 11-13 years of age as of December 31 each calendar year.

Senior:

Exhibitors who are 14-18 years of age as of December 31 of each calendar year.

Grange Members

Must be at least 5 years old on December 31 of each calendar year to exhibit. They may exhibit until the end of the calendar year in which they reach age 19. All Grange Youth must be 9 years old on December 31 of each calendar year to exhibit large animals.
